Proposals must include the followings:

Paper presentation: The proposal should not be more than 300 words explaining the contribution to the field and a concise summary. It should include the author's/authors' names, affiliation, contact details and a short biographical note.

The length of submissions is expected to be up to 300 words (Conference papers) or up to 500 words (workshops). All proposals will be double-blind peer reviewed. Please send your papers to esp@teachers.org by 20 July 2017. Acceptance of papers will be announced on 05 August 2017.
